IT IS ORDERED that the amendments to Rules 83 of the Rules of Procedure for the Juvenile Court, which the Court adopted on an emergency basis on August 25, 2021, are hereby adopted permanently in accordance with the attachment to this order, effective January 1, 2022. The amendments shown on the attachment are the same as the amendments shown on the attachment to this Court's August 25, 2021 order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, consistent with this Court's December 2021 order regarding R-20-0044, Rule 83 as amended will be abrogated, effective July 1, 2022.

RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR THE JUVENILE COURT

Rule 83. Documentation Required to Adopt

A. Within ten (10) days prior to the finalization of an adoption, the petitioner shall provide to the court the following documents, if applicable:

8. ~~Notarized statements from any birth parent granting or denying permission for the child being adopted to obtain identifying information about the child and the consenting parent upon the child reaching twenty one (21) years of age and granting or denying permission to be informed of the death of the child, as provided by law~~ Any birth parent's notarized statement as described in A.R.S. § 8-106, and contact preference form as described in A.R.S. § 36-340;
