Rule 28(h)(1) Motion for Expedited
Consideration

Pursuant to Rule 28(h)(1), Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona, Petitioner moves this Court for an order granting expedited consideration of this petition to amend the Rules of Procedure for Judicial Performance Review (“JPR”) in the State of Arizona as recommended by the JPR Task Force established by Administrative Order 2023-24. Granting expedited consideration will allow this Court to consider this late-filed petition at its 2023 annual rules agenda.

If this motion is not granted, the petition will not be considered until the 2024 rules agenda under Rule 28(a)(1). Key amendments proposed by the Task Force are capable of implementation for the 2024 retention election if they become effective

October 1, 2023. This is only possible if the petition is considered at the 2023 annual rules agenda.

The petition requests an effective date of October 1, 2023, and an order modifying the comment period to permit the petition's expedited consideration at the 2023 annual rules agenda. This motion is in furtherance of those requests.
