Rule 42. Arizona Rules of Professional Conduct

ER 1.4. Communication

(a)-(c) [No change]

(d) All lawyers/legal paraprofessionals in private practice shall inform the client in writing, prior to or at the commencement of the representation, if they do not have professional liability insurance. If notice has not been provided at or before the commencement of the representation, the lawyer/legal paraprofessional shall inform the client in writing within thirty (30) days of the date the lawyer/legal paraprofessional knows that the lawyer/legal paraprofessional no longer has professional liability insurance during the representation.
