RULES OF FAMILY LAW PROCEDURE

Rule 2. Applicability of the Arizona Rules of Evidence

(a) Effect of a Rule 2(a) Notice; Time for Filing. Any party may file a notice to require compliance with the Arizona Rules of Evidence at a hearing or trial. A party must file the notice at least 45 days before the hearing or trial, or by another date set by the court. If a hearing or trial is set fewer than 60 days in advance, the notice is deemed timely if a party files it within a reasonable time after the party is notified of the hearing or trial date. A party's notice is only effective until such time as a judgment, as defined by Rule 78(a)(1), as to all claims, issues, and parties has been entered and no further matters remain pending, as defined by Rule 78(c).
