PETITION FOR RELEASE OF RESTRICTED FUNDS AND SUPPLEMENT

PETITION:

THE COURT: Okay. Are we ready on the David Redkey matter?

MR. CLARKE: Yes, Your Honor.

THE COURT: This is PB2009-002224.

MR. CLARKE: Yes. William A. Clarke representing David Redkey.

THE COURT: Okay.

THE PETITIONER: David Redkey.

THE COURT: Hi.

THE PETITIONER: Representing myself. Hello.

MR. CLARKE: Your Honor, we have one additional supplement that I'd like to --

THE COURT: Okay.

MR. CLARKE: Do I file the original with you or a copy with you?

THE CLERK: Copy's fine.

THE COURT: Do you want the original?

THE CLERK: Um-hum.

THE COURT: Yeah.

MR. CLARKE: Yeah, that's the original.



1 THE COURT: Okay.

2 MR. CLARKE: Basically David said he slightly changed
3 his mind as to the exact kind of vehicle he wants, and so we've
4 modified the form of order slightly also to provide for a
5 little bit more discretion on behalf of the Petitioner as to
6 the vehicle that he wants to select.

7 THE COURT: Okay.

8 MR. CLARKE: Here are forms of order, Your Honor.

9 THE COURT: Okay. So my understanding of the
10 petition was one, the request for the car, and then request for
11 additional funds for the dental work. That exceeded what we
12 had already kind of done, I guess, for --

13 MR. CLARKE: Yes.

14 THE COURT: -- for the dental work and then a
15 reinstatement of his privilege to drive. Is that what you're
16 asking for?

17 MR. CLARKE: I'm not sure that his privilege to drive
18 was ever --

19 THE COURT: Revoked?

20 MR. CLARKE: -- revoked.

21 THE COURT: Okay.

22 MR. CLARKE: But it said make sure that that issue
23 is --

24 THE COURT: Clear.

25 MR. CLARKE: -- clear. If you --



1 THE COURT: Okay.

2 MR. CLARKE: -- don't mind going ahead and
3 reinstating his right to drive. I never actually saw a court
4 order that says --

5 THE COURT: And is it just a conservatorship?

6 MR. CLARKE: Yes, it is.

7 THE COURT: Okay. So it might not have --

8 MR. CLARKE: Yes.

9 THE COURT: -- ever -- I mean, typically that would
10 be --

11 MR. CLARKE: A guardianship.

12 THE COURT: Right. Mr. Redkey has --

13 THE PETITIONER: Yeah, because I went through a
14 driving evaluation, it actually was already taken care of. The
15 doctor signed off on it and I got the -- the release from -- I
16 mean, they were originally going to suspend my license on --
17 originally on Christmas Day, but because I got the release from
18 the doctor, everything is fine with the license itself, so I
19 can actually drive.

20 THE COURT: Okay.

21 MR. CLARKE: If you wouldn't mind, though, add a
22 sentence to the order that it --

23 THE COURT: Okay.

24 MR. CLARKE: -- clarifies that so we don't have any
25 confusion.

1 THE COURT: Okay. Okay. Anything else you want to
2 present with regards to that? And it looks like J.P. Morgan is
3 the conservators?

4 MR. CLARKE: Yes, J.P. Morgan is the conservator.

5 THE COURT: Okay. And they were notified and
6 everything?

7 MR. CLARKE: They received notice and I actually
8 consulted with them by telephone before we came over here
9 today.

10 THE COURT: Okay. Okay. Anything else you want to
11 present with regards to the request?

12 MR. CLARKE: Only if you need anything further, Your
13 Honor.

14 THE COURT: I mean, I have reviewed the request. I
15 think there was sufficient documentation provided to -- with
16 the petition to justify the release of the funds. I'm just
17 trying to figure out -- I was trying to remember if there was a
18 specific -- is it just being held -- J.P. Morgan has just all
19 of the funds together? They --

20 MR. CLARKE: J.P. Morgan holds the funds. The way
21 the account actually works, is J.P. Morgan is holding the
22 funds. They provide him a monthly stipend for living expenses.
23 This is a supplemental request for distribution and J.P. Morgan
24 will pay the doctor directly. They will pay for the car
25 directly. They will pay for the insurance directly under the

1 form of order that I've given you.

2 THE COURT: Okay.

3 (Pause)

4 THE COURT: Okay. I mean, the main change to the
5 form of order is just the change in the car, correct?

6 MR. CLARKE: Yes, Your Honor. Just specifying that
7 any of the --

8 THE COURT: Prius over the summer.

9 MR. CLARKE: Yeah. The conservator is authorized to
10 spend up to \$36,000 for a vehicle. And we're actually leaving
11 the choice of --

12 THE COURT: Okay.

13 MR. CLARKE: -- the vehicle up to the Petitioner
14 (indiscernible).

15 THE COURT: Okay. Up to -- to decide at some point.

16 MR. CLARKE: Yes.

17 THE COURT: Okay. Okay. I will go ahead and grant
18 the request for the release of the funds as specified in the
19 petition and the order and I will sign off on that at this
20 point. And then I'm assuming the conservator will just reflect
21 that in the accounting?

22 MR. CLARKE: Yes.

23 THE COURT: Okay. Okay. And I did add to the order
24 that the privilege to drive is reinstated --

25 MR. CLARKE: Thank you, Your Honor.



1 THE COURT: -- if that's necessary. Okay?

2 MR. CLARKE: Thank you very much.

3 THE COURT: Okay. Thank you.

4 THE PETITIONER: Thank you, Your Honor.

5 MR. CLARKE: Thank you very much.

6 THE COURT: Thank you.
