I wish to have an appointment with the appropriate duty officer or assigned legal counsel to discuss the following critical issues, which cripple Arizona:


- 1) The amendment to change Arizona Supreme Court Rule 53 must be abolished. This proposal is also known as R-24-0046.
- 2) This amendment sabotages the duty of the State Bar to do its assignment to discipline lawyers who violate the Rules of Professional Conduct.
- 3) State Bar only disciplines 1% of the 3,000 annual complaints anyway.
- 4) State Bar additionally fails to obey its required Ariz. Sup. Ct. Rule 32.
- 5) In addition, the Commission on Judicial Conduct fails its duty too.
- 6) For these reasons, Arizona's judicial system is broken and must be fixed.

As a citizen, on March 19, 2024, over ten years ago, I witnessed a police shooting wherein the police lied and the innocent victim was forced into a false plea and spent 7.5 years in prison for a crime he did not do.

This misconduct is far from isolated. It constantly occurs. Well over 1,000 have been wrongfully shot in Arizona, due to this uncontrolled police brutality.
