Require Opportunity for Public Comment at the beginning of the meeting

Rule 4. Meetings and Actions

(a) – (d) [No changes]

(e) **Public Participation.** Except as provided in (b)(2) and (h), all Commission meetings are open to the public and, except as provided in (b)(3), must include a call to the public to allow individuals to address the Commission on the judicial performance review process or the performance of any judges subject to retention.

(1) – (2) [No changes]

(3) Any meeting where public comment is allowed, the public must be given the opportunity to address the Commission at the beginning of the meeting, prior to any business taking place other than calling the meeting to order and approval of the minutes.

(f) – (h) [No changes]
