

IFLT rules that would apply unless a party requested that they not apply in that party's case.

On March 7, 2025, the Committee moved to amend its petition in R-24-0060 to substantially scale back its proposed rule changes. The amended petition no longer proposes adopting IFLT rules but instead proposes amending Rules 22 and 77 of the Rules of Family Law Procedure merely to direct trial judges to conduct the direct-examination of every self-represented party in a case. This Court granted the motion to amend on March 21, 2025.

In light of the amended petition filed in R-24-0060, Petitioners have filed a motion to withdraw their petition in this matter.

Upon consideration,

IT IS ORDERED granting the motion to withdraw Rule Petition R-22-0007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this petition is deemed withdrawn.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall close the file in this matter.
