RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT OF ARIZONA

Rule 32. Organization of the State Bar of Arizona

(a)–(d) [No change]

(e) **Composition of the Board of Governors.** The board is composed of ~~sixteen~~ seventeen elected governors and ten appointed governors, as provided by this Rule. Only governors elected or appointed under this Rule are empowered to vote at board meetings.

4. *Senior Lawyers Division President.* In addition to those governors elected under Rule 32(e)(2), the elected president of the Senior Lawyers Division will serve as a voting member of the board of governors. The election of the Senior Lawyers Division president will be conducted as provided by the Senior Lawyers Division’s bylaws. The Senior Lawyers Division president will serve a one-year term on the board and may be in a retired or inactive status throughout the elected term.
