

SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT OF COMPETENCY: REVISED COMPLIANCE OVERSIGHT STRUCTURE

I. MANDATORY COMPLIANCE OVERSIGHT STRUCTURE

To maintain authorization to practice, all QARs and QRPs are required to operate under the continuous review of qualified legal professionals. The revised CLA structure shall be enforced as follows:

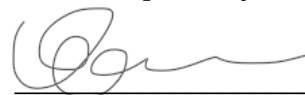
A. Single-State Practice: A QAR or QRP operating exclusively within one (1) jurisdiction must be under the direct supervision and compliance review of at least one (1) licensed attorney in good standing within that specific state.

B. Multi-Jurisdictional Practice: For QARs or QRPs practicing across multiple states, the Petitioner mandates the retention of two (2) additional Compliance Licensed Attorneys/Practitioners. To fulfill this requirement, one of these additional compliance professionals may be a Limited Licensed Legal Practitioner (LLLP) in good standing, while the other must be a licensed attorney in good standing. This structure ensures that all administrative advocacy, prosecutorial actions, and filings maintain rigorous ethical and legal oversight regardless of the operational territory.

II. ACCOUNTABILITY AND PUBLIC PROTECTION

This oversight requirement ensures that the non-lawyer representative—whether performing defense (QAR) or prosecutorial (QRP/Private Attorney General) functions—maintains seamless adherence to the legal and ethical standards required by the oversight of three total legal professionals in a multi-state context.
