Petitioner moves this Court to extend the time for filing a Reply in this matter. The Reply due date is currently June 30, 2026. Petitioner requests an extension until October 2, 2026. In conjunction with that request, Petitioner asks the Court to consider R-25-0059 at its December 2026 Rules Agenda, rather than at its August 2026 Rules Agenda.

The Task Force was notified that the Superior Court in Maricopa County has requested additional time to file its comment. The Task Force is amenable to an extension and allowing that court until July 2, 2026, to submit its comment. The Task Force has a meeting set for June 5 that was scheduled months in advance. With the Superior Court’s extension in mind, however, the Task Force will need an additional meeting to review that comment, as well to assess the status of pending legislation that may affect the proposed rules. Several factors, including the Judicial Conference, the State Bar Convention, judicial rotations, and other scheduling
