This comment is limited to a recommendation that proposed juvenile rule 94(B)(1) be modified to prevent listing the applicant's complete social security number on the petition for emancipation. Identity theft continues to spur debate across the country and within Arizona. The legislature and courts are continually attempting to strike the balance between the public's right to access public records and the individual's ability to protect their personal interests.
