#### I. REASONS OF CPS INVOLVEMENT

##### A. Brief statement of grounds for petition.

As of December 6, 2005, there was no one to care for Vincent and Giorgio. Giorgio appeared not to have any special needs, but Vincent was developmentally disabled. The Mother, Linda Martinger, was homeless and needed to have the children placed together so that she could get back on her feet. Mother had no food, money, or means to care for the boys. Vincent's father may have been able to care for him, but Mother did not know where he was. Giorgio's father has been missing for 5 years. Uncle Javier Sossell said he would clear out a room for the boys, but only if CPS placed them there. It is not know if the Uncle meant this. Mother said she could not place the children with other relatives because her relatives will not speak to her. Mother called two homeless shelters, but they were all full. Mother state she is depressed and on the verge of a nervous breakdown.

##### A. If applicable, describe efforts made to locate missing parent.

Parent locators on 2/09/06 and 7/07/06 for Michael McVann. Locator completed on 2/08/06 and 7/07/06 for Jacob Sossell.

##### B. Services provided to eliminate the need for continued out-of-home placement and outcome of services.

The services provided include parent aide, visitation, substance abuse treatment through Terros Families First, counseling, and drug testing through TASC. The Mother was also provided with a Psychological and Psychiatric Evaluation. She failed to complete the Psychiatric Evaluation but did complete the Psychological Evaluation. Mother continues to be not consistent in completing her services. Mother was given more time to complete her services and to become knowledgeable about how to care for a DDD child, such as Vincent . Mother has not taken advantage of this opportunity. Since June 2007, Mother has missed 10 UAs, on average about one time per week. She did not complete the Aftercare program for Terros, which the DDD Case Manager reminded her to complete. She called this
