Pursuant to your request, your name was removed from the list of applicants for the above examination. In accordance with rules for admission of applicants to the practice of law in Arizona:

Rule 37 (continued)

(d) An applicant who submits an application for admission by examination and who has paid the fees required by these rules and thereafter withdraws the application or fails to appear for the examination applied for, shall be entitled to a partial refund or credit of the fees paid, as established by the Court, **provided the applicant notifies the Committee in writing no later than the filing deadline for that examination as set by the Court.** (Emphasis added.)

As your withdrawal letter was received after the filing deadline, you are not eligible for a partial refund.

If you elect to file for an examination subsequent to July 2017, you will be required to submit a new application for admission online and mail supporting documents. Registration for February 2018 begins August 15, 2017 to November 30, 2017.
