The Arizona Prosecuting Attorneys' Advisory Council (APAAC) by and through Edwin M. Cook, its Executive Director, joins in support of the Comment filed by Arizona Attorney General Goddard in opposition to the State Bar of Arizona's Petition to Amend Rule 111 of the Arizona Supreme Court and Rule 28 of the Arizona Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure. APAAC opposes both Proposals suggested by the State Bar, with the caveats that it has no objection to making unpublished memorandum decisions electronically available to the public and lawyers, and to amending ARCAP 28 to simply reference Supreme Court Rule 111, rather than reiterating the Rule. The reasons for this opposition are the same as set forward in the Comment filed by the Attorney General.
