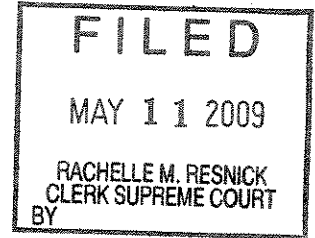


re: Rule Change Petition No. R-08-0012
